Training for all Saturday Mornings

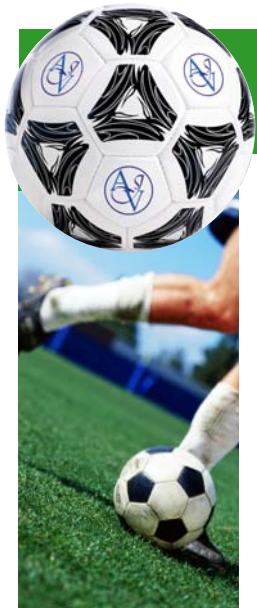
FA Qualified Coaches take a training session from 9:30am till 11:00am every Saturday at Chorley RUFC, Chancery Road.

1st half- Both teams started strong and on the attack. Both had chances but the keepers were playing well, and though both sides looked like they could score neither had a good enough chance.

There were a couple of hard but fare tackles which added Four minutes of extra time to the first half.

The stalemate was only broken when at twenty eight minutes Haywood for Astley launched an attack into the 13 yard box and was upended for his effort. The Referee blew for a penalty and Noblett came up from the defense to fire one low and hard under the Bamber Bridge Keeper who had dived the right way. Nine more minutes of end to end play saw the half end 0-1 in Astleys' favour.
